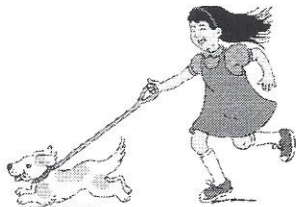

Dogs & Their Owners' Responsibilities ...

Not many lodging facilities on Galveston allow dogs, so please know that it is a privilege that your dogs—limit of two (2) per condo—are welcome here. Keep in mind that this is not a dog park, however, and precautions must be taken to ensure this privilege continues. If you brought furry family members with you, here are a few tips and rules:



• ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES.

Dogs must be on leashes when outside of condos at all times. Do not open your condo door without having your dog on a leash. Many dogs have been surprised by another dog already in the hallway, leading to stressed dogs and dog owners. When taking your dog on or off the elevator, hold a tight grip on the leash and keep your dog away from the doorway until it opens and you are sure no other dogs are waiting to enter or exit the elevator. Again, many dogs have been surprised at the elevators.



• SCOOP THE POOP!

The grassy area on the east side of the complex between the parking area and the gravel access road (the side with the tall green building) has been designated as a "pet walking /potty" area. Pick up your dog's poop! There are plastic bags provided in the dog-walking areas. Or you can bring your own plastic grocery bag. Throw all bags into the dumpster or trash can in the dog area. Do not let your dog pee or poop in any common areas (hallways, elevators, doormats, garage, potted plants, etc.). Plan your dog's outing before he has an accident. And, again, always pickup your dog's poop!

If you've never used a plastic bag to scoop the poop, here's how you do it:

- (1) Place your hand inside the bag.
- (2) Pick up the poop with your "gloved" hand, then turn the plastic bag down around your hand to "bag" the poop.
- (3) Then throw the bag in the trash.

There is NO poop fairy!

• THIS ISN'T A DOG PARK.

Keep in mind that not all dogs—or dog owners—want to your dog. Do not take it personally. Do not approach other dogs with your dog. You do not know how other dogs will react. They are away from their homes, in foreign territory, and may become aggressive.

• DOGS MUST HAVE CURRENT RABIES SHOT.



All pets must be in compliance with local ordinances. In Galveston County, pets must have a current rabies shot and must be leashed at all times. Animals (specific animals or breeds so identified) that have demonstrated vicious or aggressive behavior must be covered by a pet liability policy or be removed from the premises. No aggressive dogs (pitbulls, dobermans, Rottweilers, etc. are allowed on premises.) No dogs over 50 pounds are allowed.

• DOGS (& OWNERS) MUST BE ON BEST BEHAVIOR.

Any pet causing or creating unreasonable disturbance or noise may be permanently removed from the property. You, the pet owner, may have to compensate any person hurt or bitten by your pet, whether while in your immediate care or the care of a designee, and will hold the Maravilla harmless from any claim that may result from any action of your pet whatsoever.

• DOGS CANNOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED.

In no event will any animal be left unattended, whether tethered or not, anywhere on the property. Also, it's a state law that you cannot leave a dog unattended in a vehicle. Your dog will be sent to jail (Galveston County Humane Society) and you will have to pay a large fee to bail him out.



• DOGS CANNOT BE IN POOL AREAS.

No animal of any kind or nature shall be inside the fencing to any pools or hot tub, the office, or the exercise room at any time No exceptions!

• GOOD FORTUNE!

DOGS CAN GO TO THE BEACH!

Dogs are allowed on beaches if on a leash you must clean up the poop!
